

Student Gmail Directions: Sophomores, Juniors & Seniors

To login to your GMAIL account, open your browser and type directly in the address bar gmail.d230.org, and proceed with the below directions OR go to your school website: <http://stagg.d230.org/> and click on the 'Students' link in the top left corner of the screen.



Click on the Gmail link

USER NAME: is your Student ID#@d230.org

For example: 121212@d230.org

PASSWORD: is the same password you created last year to login to the computers at school.
