	<p style="text-align: center;">Pink Emergency Information Sheet</p> <p>This form should be completed and turned in at your registration.</p>	May 26, 2017
	<p style="text-align: center;">Certificate of Child Health Exam</p> <p><i>State of Illinois form must be completed and signed by a licensed physician, APN, or PA. This requirement applies to transfer students also. Note: Obtaining a copy of your child's 6th grade physical may help your physician complete the immunization section of this form. Form MUST show the following immunizations:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Tetanus Diphtheria, Pertussis series with Tdap booster ● Two (2) doses of measles, mumps, rubella vaccine (MMR) – 1st dose having been given on or after the 1st birthday ● Polio vaccine series with booster given on or after the 4th birthday ● Two (2) doses of varicella vaccine (the 1st dose having been given on or after the 1st birthday) ● Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B according to the required schedule ● Two doses of Meningococcal vaccine administered at least 8 weeks apart or one dose after the 16th birthday is required for all seniors. 	May 26, 2017
	Parents/Guardians will complete and sign the Health History section on the back of the physical form. Incomplete or unsigned forms will be returned.	May 26, 2017
	An Asthma Action Plan is required from the doctor for all asthmatic students.	May 26, 2017

Copy the Health Exam Form for the Athletic Department. Keep a copy for yourself. Send the original to the Nurse as noted above.</p>	After May 1, 2017
	<p style="text-align: center;">Dental Examinations</p> <p>Strongly recommended but not required for entrance into school.</p>	Recommended
	<p style="text-align: center;">State of Illinois Eye Examination Report</p> <p>Required for students entering the Illinois School System for the first time.</p>
