



Global Navigator Scholarships

Looking for the opportunity for a life-changing experience in the summer--learn about the CIEE and Sandburg's status as a Global Navigator School.

Sandburg recently formed a partnership with the CIEE and was granted status as a Global Navigator School for the 2017-2018 school year. As a member of this partnership, Sandburg students have access at minimum to a dedicated amount of \$25,000 in scholarships for traveling abroad in the summer. This money is in addition to the \$5.4 million available in scholarships nationwide. Full and partial scholarships are available to our students, which can significantly offset the costs of travel and in some cases nearly eliminate the costs altogether. This partnership is intended to provide Sandburg students access to transformative experiences, with programs tailored to the specific interests of individual students.

Eligibility:

- All current freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible for scholarships.
- Freshmen, sophomores, and juniors who elect to apply to one of 70+ CIEE Summer High School Abroad programs will be considered for the awards, based on both merit and need.

Program Info:

- Beginning in summer 2018, CIEE will have over 10 new programs in new locations, such as Rome, Prague, and Perth.
- CIEE runs three major strands of experiences in the summer, including a language immersion program which qualifies for college credit, service learning programs, and a global discovery program. Programs span between three and four weeks.

Important Deadlines:

- **December 1:** Early application deadline for students to submit online program and scholarship application (75% of funds are awarded by that date, so you should meet the deadline)
- **Mid December:** Students notified of program acceptance and scholarship award
- **Late December:** Deadline for students to accept or decline awards
- **February 15:** Final program application deadline
